When do the choirs meet?

Preschool – Kindergarten Musictime meets MOST Tuesdays September through April during one of two sessions:

4:15 - 4:40pm

4:40 - 5:05pm

Just pick which session works best for you AND it's OK if you switch sessions depending on your schedule. $1^{st} - 5^{th}$ Grade Choir Praise Choir meets MOST Tuesdays September through April 5:05 – 5:45pm

What if we can't come every week?

Family schedules flex throughout the school year and that's OK. Come join us when you can: once a month, for a few months at a time, all school year – regular attendance is not required. ©

Does my preschooler need to be potty trained?

No! © If a child needs the washroom during choir they will come to YOU in the lobby for assistance.

Do I need to be a member of Hosanna!?

All children are welcome to be a part of Children's Choirs regardless of church membership so bring your friends!

Can I run errands during choir?

Parents/guardians of preschool – kindergarten children <u>MUST</u> stay in the building during *Musictime*. Parents/guardians of 1st – 5th grade students may designate an adult friend to "be our go to" in the lobby if your child needs assistance.

Is my child required to sing in worship?
